

## CHECKLIST FOR CHILD OF ITALIAN/EU CITIZEN

<b>1.</b>	<b>ENTRY VISA APPLICATION FORM</b>
	COMPLETELY filled in “Schengen Visa” Application Form (for visa applicants visiting the EU citizen) or National Visa Application Form (for visa applicants intending to settle in Italy)
<b>2.</b>	<b>PHOTO</b>
	One (1) recent passport-sized 35x40mm colored ICAO standard photo with white background
<b>3.</b>	<b>TRAVEL DOCUMENT</b>
	Current valid passport (expiry date is three months longer than that of the visa requested)
	Photocopy of Biodata page, previous visa and immigration stamps in all countries
<b>4.</b>	<b>PROOF OF TRAVEL</b>
	One-way Flight Booking
<b>5.</b>	<b>INVITATION</b>
	Proof of Sponsorship and/or Private Accommodation (format of this letter may be downloaded on the VFS Global website). It should be filled up properly and signed by the host. The host in Italy must indicate on the document if the visa applicant is visiting (Schengen visa) or going to settle (National Visa)
<b>6.</b>	<b>PROOF OF RELATIONSHIP</b>
	Clear photocopy of the passport of the Italian Spouse
	Photocopy of Birth Certificate of the visa applicant showing the name of the Italian citizen as a parent.
<b>7.</b>	<b>This also applies for children of spouses of Italian citizens, with a Marriage Certificate registered in Italy.</b>
<b>8.</b>	<b>In the case of minors from No. 7. above, the application must be accompanied by the written and signed consent of the other biological parent with a copy of their identification document, or a court order granting the spouse of the Italian citizen full custody of the child, or if the biological father is unknown, the birth certificate must be certified by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.</b>

*Notes:*

- *Only visa applications whose intended date of travel is within six (6) months from the time of application will be accepted*
